This letter is intended to serve two functions. The first is to provide a call for papers for the first meeting of the Memory Disorders Research Society, which will be held in Boston on October 26-27, 1989. I am planning to have at least four symposia on specific topics, which leaves time for papers on a variety of other diverse topics. If you would like to present a paper, please just send me the title of your talk which you should plan to have last about 20 minutes. In order to put the program together and distribute it ahead of time, it will be necessary to make the deadline for these title submissions be July 28, 1989.

The second reason I am writing is to make another request. I would like to compile a bibliography of all articles, books, and book chapters with which each member has been involved during 1987, 1988, and 1989. I will collate these references from all your responses and provide the list at the meeting. An annual, or biannual, updating of this listing can keep each member informed of the publication sources of the membership which clearly represents a core of the profession. At this time, would you put together a list of your publications and send it to me no later than September 1, 1989. I will then make the entire collection available at the meeting. Since this is part of an educational component of our Center Grant, there will be no expense to the membership for the list.

Thus, there are two deadlines of interest:

- Submission of paper titles - July 28
- Send list of your 87-89 publications - September 1
